

Caleb and Henry Bailey Greenwood Loudoun County, Virginia 1768 – 1771

Index to the Tithables of Loudoun County, Virginia, and to Slaveholders and Slaves, 1758-1786

Caleb Greenwood and his son Henry Bailey Greenwood are listed in the records of Loudoun County Virginia's "tithables" (taxes). In 1991, Margaret Hopkins created an index of these records.

While the title does say "Index to the Tithables of Loudoun County, Virginia, and to Slaveholders and Slaves, 1758-1786", the Index to the Slaveholders and Slaves starts on page 101. Caleb and Henry are not listed in that section.

In the beginning of the book she states that Loudoun County was established in 1757, but parishes were the collectors of the taxes before and continued up until the county government finally took over. Shelburne Parish was established later in 1769 but not reflected in the list of tithables until 1771.

The numbers next to the names are the years and the letter "s" stands for Shelburne County.

Caleb is listed for the years 1768, 1770 & 1771. Henry is only shown for 1771.
