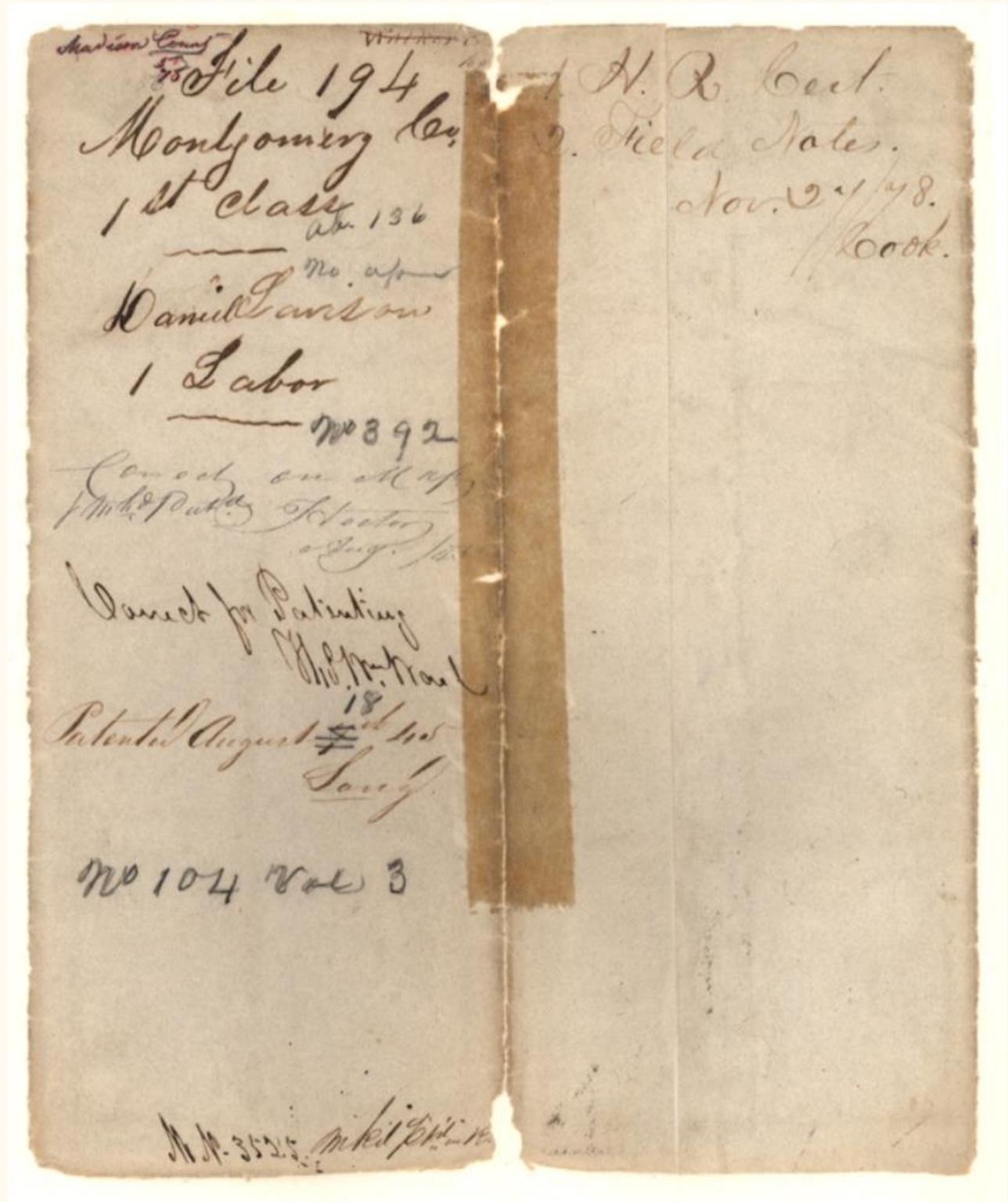


Daniel Milton Larrison

Spanish Land Grant 1835 – Montgomery County, Texas



No 392

This is to certify that Daniel Larison has appeared before the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Montgomery and proved according to law, that he arrived in this Country in 1820 and that he is a man of family and entitled to One labor of land upon the condition of paying at the rate of \$350 for each labor Irregular, lands \$250 for each labor of Temporal or Arable Land and \$120 for each labor of Pasture land which may be contained in the Survey secured to him by this Certificate.

Given under our hands the 21st day of June 1838.
